

Information about pre-graduation Practical Assessment (PPV)

WHAT PPV CONSISTS OF

The Practical Assessment (PPV) aims to assess the candidate's ability to critically reflect on the contents and on the activities carried out during the Practical Evaluation Internship (TPV). It also includes aspects of legislation and professional ethics. The candidate shall demonstrate the ability to adopt a professional approach, based on theoretical models and evidence, and to have acquired adequate technical-professional skills.

ASSESSMENT MODALITIES

The PPV consists in an interview and takes place only in person. Only after having obtained a positive evaluation at the PPV the student is allowed to proceed to the discussion of their thesis.

TO TAKE THE PPV

The PPV is part of the Final Examination. To take it, the student shall submit the graduation application in Uniweb and fulfill all the obligations related to the submission of this application including for instance: ensuring that the study plan is correct and complete, respecting the deadlines for the registration of all exams, and uploading the final thesis.

FEE

The payment of the state and regional fees is required before the PPV (see the "Qualifying Degrees" section at <https://www.unipd.it/en/graduation>). It is not necessary to send or show the payment receipts to the Commission. If the PPV is not passed, the state and regional fees already paid will remain valid for subsequent graduation periods.

COMPOSITION OF THE COMMISSION

The PPV commission is composed of at least four members: two university professors, one of whom serves as President, and two members designated by the Board of the Order of Psychologists. International students are allowed to take the PPV in English.

SCHEDULE

The schedule of the PPV and the members of the Commissions will be published in the "Exam Registration Verification" section in Uniweb approximately 5 days before the beginning of the dedicated period.
