### 12 OPTIONAL CREDITS (cfu/ects)

Second-cycle/Master's degree students may choose course units worth optional credits from the current Second-cycle/Master's degree programs of the University of Padova (including those belonging to the School of Psychology) as well as from their degree program. In addition, students may choose course units worth optional credits from the First-cycle/Bachelor's degree programs with the exception of those belonging to the School of Psychology. In any case, students cannot choose course units they already took or equivalent courses (mutuazioni). A Study Plan including course units worth optional credits chosen among other degree programs not belonging to the School of Psychology's offer will have to be submitted to the Director of the Degree Course's approval. Activities such as "Other activities" and "Language/final examination" cannot be selected as course units worth optional credits.
